

### **Clusters matter in Europe**

- 3043 **strong clusters** account for more than 54 million jobs
- Gazelles in strong clusters employ 35 staff compared to 24 elsewhere
- Wages in strong clusters are 3% higher than elsewhere
- 40% of activity in emerging industries concentrated in 20% of regions



# Using clusters to facilitate value chain innovation & industrial transformation

Promoting collaboration and innovation across regional and sectoral silos & accelerating industrial change and smart specialisation synergies

- Cluster facilitated projects for new industrial value chains
   (Horizon2020 Innosup-1, ca. €130 million)
- European Strategic Cluster Partnerships for smart specialisation investments (COSME 2017, €2.8 million)
- Resource efficiency: Green Action Plan for SMEs ESCP.S<sup>®</sup> (European Resource Efficiency Excellence Centre, Low Carbon Business Action with Mexico, Brazil & more)
- European Observatory for Clusters & Industrial Change (COSME 2016, €2.8 million)





# Cluster facilitated projects for new industrial value chains INNOSUP-1



To develop new industrial value chains & foster emerging industries across the EU by supporting cross-sectoral & cross-regional innovation in SMEs through clusters

- → 9 ongoing projects reaching out to over 3,000 SMEs & supporting nearly 500 SMEs directly, e.g. through innovation vouchers (€60,000)
- → Max € 5 million per project with 75% of budget to support innovation in SMEs
- → during 2015-2020, INNOSUP-1 aims to support 2,000 SMEs directly (€ 130 million)

Promoting cluster cooperation for industrial leadership in global markets through

**European Strategic Cluster Partnerships for Going International (ESCP-4i)** 

- 2 "Cluster Go International" calls for proposals (2015 & 2017)
- so far 15 projects (€4.3 mln)
- → 98 cluster organisations representing over 10,000 SMEs
- 2018-2019 → 23 new projects launched (€5.8 mln)
- Supporting joint international strategies & collaboration with partners in third countries for the benefit of SMFs

#### Cluster Excellence programme

To raise innovation capacity & competitiveness of clusters by focusing on cluster management


- •COSME calls (€8.25m)
- → 11 projects with 57 clusters organizations & 83 cluster managers involved for the benefit of almost 11,000 SMEs
- •Cluster Excellence Initiative (2nd phase with €300,000 ad-hoc grant)
- → Review & improve the European cluster labelling system
- → Set clear European Principles to increase transparency, accountability & efficiency
- → Reinforce cluster management excellence expertise across the EU & worldwide
- → Build-up an inclusive & sustainable management structure for the labelling process at EU level
