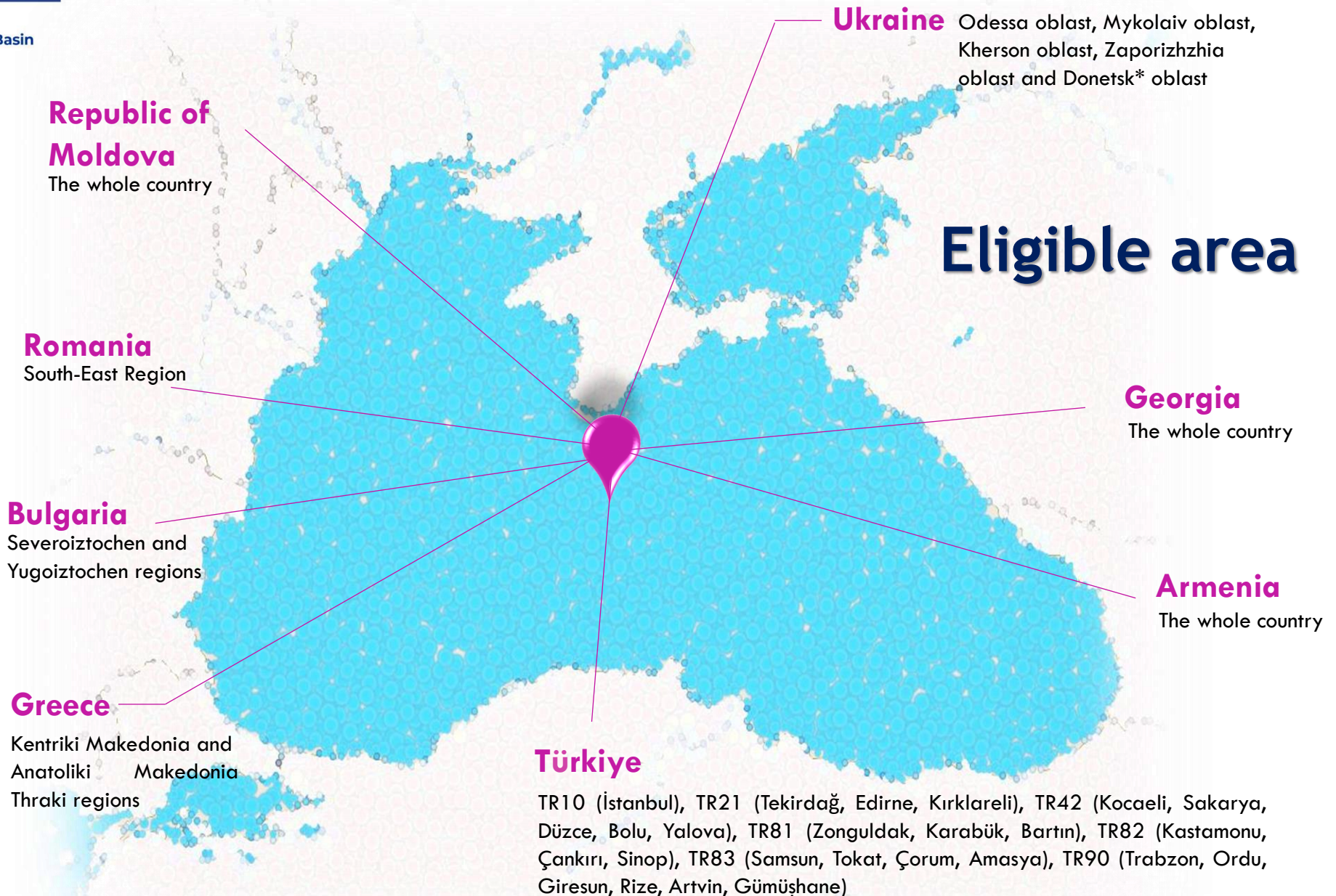

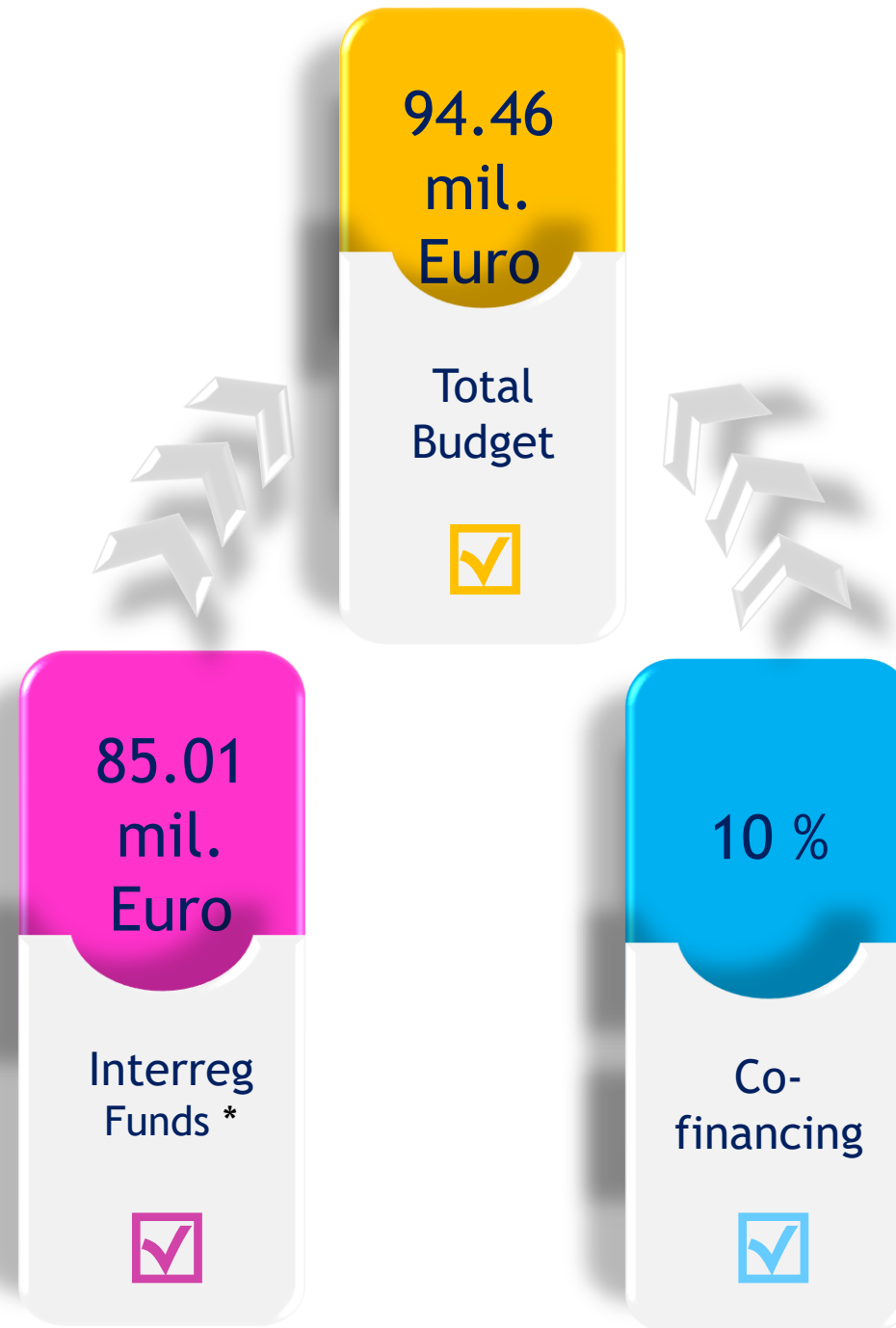
- Governed by the EU Cohesion policy;

Budget

- * **Interreg Funds:**
 - **ERDF** (European Regional Development Fund)
 - **NDICI - Global Europe** (Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument)
 - **IPA** (Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance)



Eligible applicants:

- **Public authorities** (e.g. regional/county council, local council, municipality, ministries, etc.);
- **Bodies governed by public law** (e.g. state/regional owned institutes, universities and educational institutions, regional development agencies, nature parks and protected areas management bodies, research institutes, etc.);
- **Non-profit organizations** (e.g. associations, unions, foundations, private universities, Local Action Groups, Euro regions, European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation, etc.).

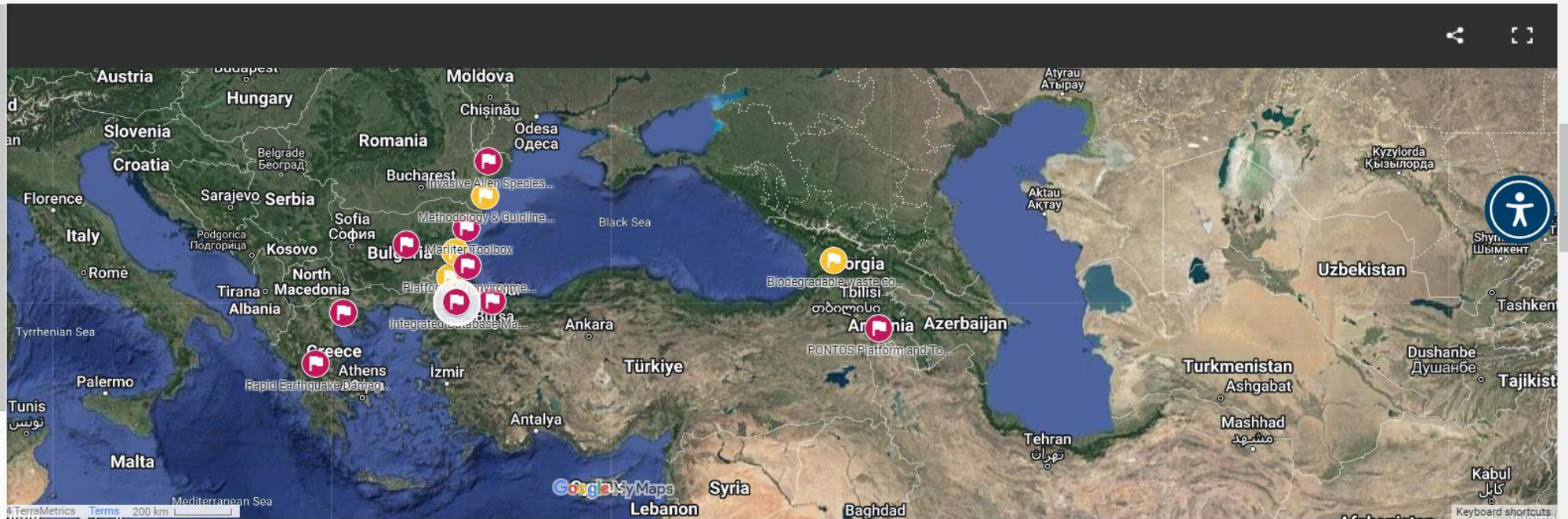

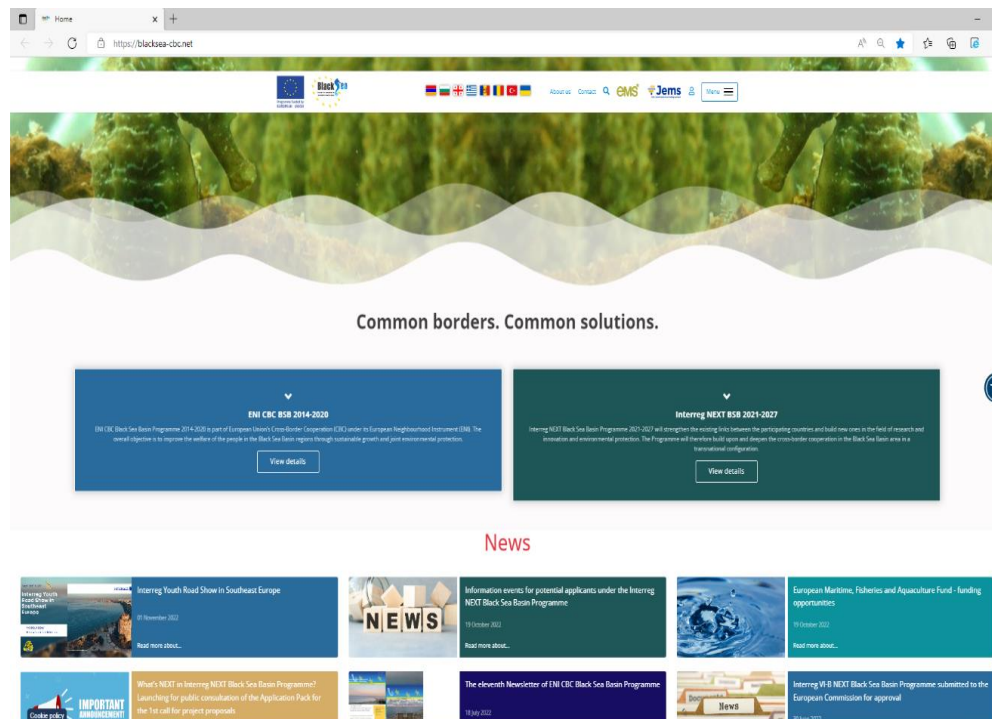

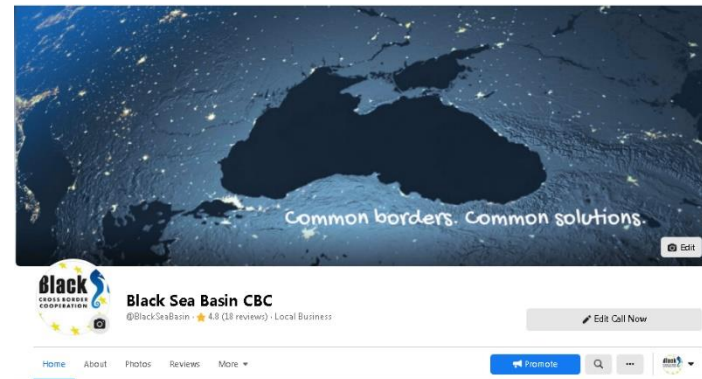
