### **Economic profile of India**

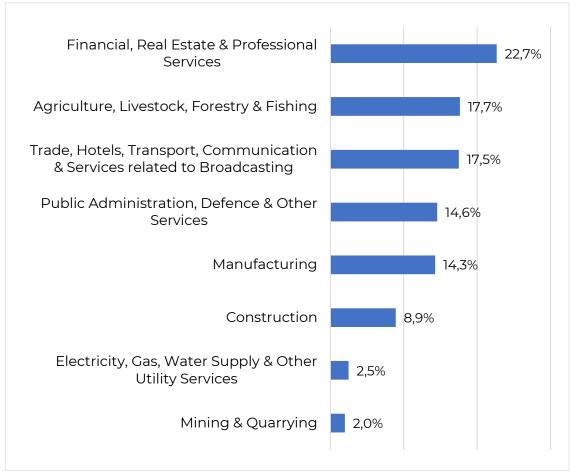
#### General characteristics of the economy:

- Over the last 30 years, the GDP grew from EUR 537 billion to EUR 2883 billion (constant 2015 EUR) – an average growth rate of 6%
- One of the fastest-growing economies in recent years
- 5<sup>th</sup> biggest economy in the world
- GDP per capita varies strongly between regions (from EUR 570 in Bihar to EUR 5,800 in Goa)

#### **Predominant sectors:**

- Strong services, especially IT being the driving force behind the growth of the Indian service sector.
- ICT alone accounts for 30% of Indian exports.
- Manufacturing as well as agriculture represent relevant shares of the Indian economy.

## **EU-Indian trade: Most relevant EU trading partners for India**

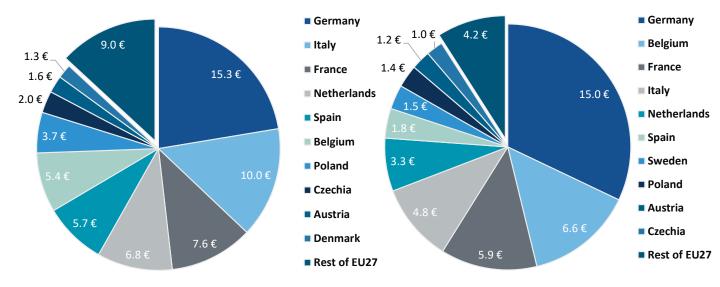
- EU is the most important trading partner for India
- Trade volume of around EUR 115 bn in 2022
- Trade in services amounted to EUR 50.8 bn in 2023
- DE, IT, FR, BE & FR as stand-out partners

## Value chain analysis: 7 industrial ecosystems with most promising potential for further cooperation

#### **Aerospace & Defence**



Aeroplanes & other aircraft (EUR 4.1 bn) as well as reaction engines (EUR 0.46 bn) key commodities exported to India

#### **Digital**



Strong Indian IT sector
Telecommunications, computer, & information services account for 25% of all traded services between India & the EU

#### **Electronics**



- Growing electronics industry in India
- Electrical apparatus for switching/connecting electrical circuits among key exported commodities to India

#### **Energy Intensive Industries**



- Chemicals & related products account for ~20% of total trade
- Petroleum oil, aluminium & steel among key commodities imported from India

#### Health



- India's leading role in the manufacturing of pharmaceuticals
- Medicaments, hormones, antisera/vaccines among the most imported commodities from India

#### **Mobility-Transport-Automotive**



- Machinery & transport equipment account for 44% of all EU exports to India
- Parts & accessories of motor vehicles + pneumatic tires as key trade commodities

#### **Textiles**



- Global role of India's textile industry
- Key EU imports include footwear, T-shirts & other textiles











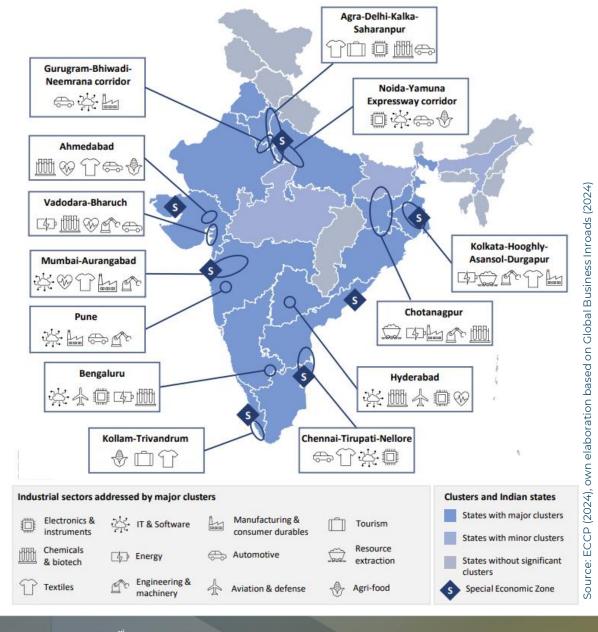
## The Indian cluster landscape

#### **Clusters**

- Map: 13 major industrial clusters
- Many more minor and micro clusters all over India
- Traditionally in chemicals & petrochemicals, automobile & components, drugs & pharmaceuticals, consumer appliances
- Increasingly in ICT, engineering and other business services

#### **Special Economic Zones**

- 2005: Special Economic Zones Act
- April 2024: 375 registered SEZs
- Map: seven central government SEZs









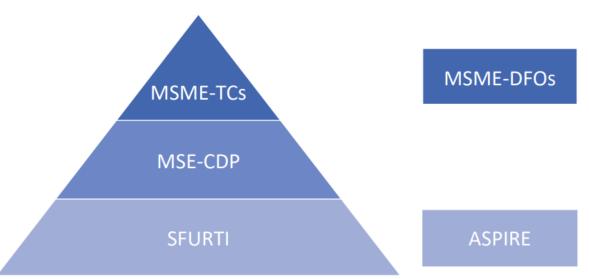




### **Cluster policy**

#### India's cluster policy portfolio

- Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) operates a set of cluster support programmes
- Core programme is the Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP)

- SWITCH Asia



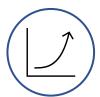








### **Final Remarks**



**India's economic growth** is primarily driven by the services sector, especially in IT and software services. The industrial sector, including key industries like manufacturing & automobiles, also plays a significant role.



Key **traded goods & commodities** between India & the EU can be linked to several EU industrial ecosystems. The currently negotiated **Free Trade Agreement** between the EU and India can be expected to further enhance trade relations.



India shows a variegated **cluster landscape** with regional agglomerations in key sectors like chemicals, electronics, pharmaceuticals, automotive & consumer appliances manufacturing, complemented by rising IT and software clusters



**Linkages** between European and Indian clusters can rely on institutions like the European Business and Technology Centre and collaborations like the EU-India Connectivity Partnership as part of the Global Gateway Initiative
