## TUI GROUP

- 62 TUI Hotels in 33 destinations in 17 countries, from Cape Verde to Vietnam, mainly All-in Resorts around the Mediterranean.
- 20.000 rooms / 45.000 beds / 10,5 million overnights / ~240 million € GOP23
- ~170 GWh electricity
- ~10,5 kg CO<sub>2e</sub> per overnight
- ~4,75 million m³ potable water
- ~430 litres per Guest and Night (including 70% of staff living at hotel)






#### **TUI Emissions – Global action!**

- TUI Hotels&Resorts Portfolio accounts for <10% of total GH Emissions of TUI Group
- SBTi Commitment 2023 THR: -46,2% reduction by 2030 / Baseline 2019.
- GHG-Emissions FY24 TUI Hotels: ~120.000 t CO<sub>2e</sub> / 18% Refrigerants.
- Scope 1 initiatives:
  - Electrification Business Case for each Hotel:
     Fossil fuel equipment, CAPEX for electric substitute, OPEX increase in electricity, OPEX decrease in fossil fuel, ROI, Financing, Subsidies...
  - Flora Carbon Sink Pilot Project at 3 Resorts. Certified Absorptions of -8,7 t CO<sub>2e</sub>, -25,6 t CO<sub>2e</sub> and -277,9 t CO<sub>2e</sub> per hotel.
- Scope 2 initiatives:
  - Zero-Carbon-Electricity production: mainly PV (CAPEX or PPA).
  - Zero-Carbon-Electricity contracting: REC for 0 kg CO<sub>2e</sub>/kWh.











### **TUI Water Stewardship** – *local action!*

- TUI Hotels&Resorts Portfolio accounts for ~87% of total water consumption of TUI Group
- Current Water initiatives:
  - "Water-Smart Hotel Guidelines"
  - Water Audits at 6 Resorts in Greece in cooperation with the Greek government
  - Pilot Hotel on Rhodes where to implement all water efficiency innovations to achieve a permanent water reduction of X% within 2 years
  - Digital Twin Hotel (Water and Energy)
